- Prostate problems can be symptomatic or non symptomatic




The Prostate Gland

- A small gland positioned under the bladder
- Essential for reproduction and sexual function
- · About the size of a walnut
- Produces the seminal fluid which makes up 90% of the ejaculate

Anatomy

- Wraps around the exit port of the bladder
- Can effect the outflow of urine
- Linked to the seminal vesicles (store sperm)
- Easily felt through the bowel wall (why a digital rectal examination is sometimes performed)

Prostate Problems


- Prostatitis
- Benign Prostatic Hypertrophy(BPH)
- Prostate Cancer





Prostatitis

- An inflammatory condition related to an infection in the urinary tract
- Causes symptoms similar to BPH
- · Common in older sexually active men
- Easily treated with antibiotics
- No long term effects following treatment

Benign Prostatic Hypertrophy

- Enlargement of the prostate tissue
- Impinges on the urine flow
- · Difficulty with passing urine
- Difficulty starting, stopping, controlling flow.
- Voiding frequently overnight
- Fine stream, dribbling, embarrassment







Treatment Options

- Medications to assist in bladder contraction
- Medications to assist outflow of urine
- TURP- resection of the internal portion of the prostate (anaesthetic!!) cautery or laser.

Full recovery, no long term effects, retention of sexual function,

Prostate Cancer

- 1 in 9 will get prostate cancer in Australia
- 3300 deaths per year!
 Higher than breast cancer
- Positive genetic link to this cancer
- This cancer gives no symptoms at all!!
- Most common in the older male yet less aggressive

- Poorer prognosis in the younger male
- Detected by blood test and rectal examination
- Multiple treatment options
- Can occur as young as forty

Treatment Options

- Watchful waiting
- Radiation therapy
- External beam
- Brachytherapy
- Seed implants
- Hormone therapy
- Surgical removal
- Natural therapies




