### Invitation

### **Hamilton Performing Arts Centre**

Brown Street, Hamilton, Victoria 3300

The Hamilton Performing Arts Centre (PAC) is the major venue for performing arts, functions and conferences in the Southern Grampians region. It is located in the heart of the Hamilton business district and is only a short stroll from the shopping strip and accommodation. The Hamilton PAC is also adjacent to the Hamilton Art gallery, famous for its outstanding collection of fine and decorative arts, and the host to the 2012 National Centre for Farmer Health Photography Competition: 'In Focus – Celebrating Farm Life'. - Sponsorship applications must be received on the official application contract form. A tax invoice will be
  issued upon receipt of this application form. The sponsorship application form is located at the back of
  this prospectus
- Sponsorship will not be assigned without a signed application and full payment upon receipt of invoice
- Full payment must be made within seven days from date of invoice
- All payments must be made in Australia dollars (see payment details on application form)
- Sponsorship investments are GST inclusive
- Payment can be made via cheque, BPay and credit card
- The organisers reserve the right at their total discretion to decline any application
- If full payment is not received, the conference organisers has the right to review the sponsorship commitment and withdraw the application

### Sponsorship cancellation policy

In exceptional circumstances the organisers will be prepared to consider cancellation of their contract with a sponsor, but only if the following conditions are complied with:

- That the request for cancellation is submitted in writing
- That the reason for the cancellations is, in the opinion of the organisers well founded
- That the sponsors agrees that the organisers shall retain 10% of the contract price if the cancellation is accepted more than six months before the conference, 50% of the contract price if the cancellation is accepted between six and two months prior to the conference and 100% of the contract price if the cancellation is accepted within two months of the opening of the conference
- Cancellation will not be considered if the organisers deem that the sponsorship entitlements have already been provided prior to the submission of the cancellation
