- The aim is to reduce the number of injuries
- Encourage farmes to work according to the Systematic Work Environment Management (SAM)
- To introduce the new provision on working with animals

- A large project called "Safe farmers Common Sense (Säkert Bondförnuft) <u>www.sakertbondfornuft.se</u>
- The aim is to reduce the number of injures in agriculture by 50 % during 2009-2013
- A nation-wide system with >100 supervisors meet farmers face to face
- Financial support by the European Union (EU)
